## SMALL IN SIZE – WITH THE RISK OF A **BIG** PROBLEM



Inside some electronic devices may be button cell batteries (lithium batteries) that if swallowed by small children can get either stuck in the throat and cause severe burns or travel into the body causing irreparable damage, severe burns and even death.

These batteries can be found in toys, musical books, key fobs, remote controls, calculators and other small devices.

Ensure your child NEVER has access to these devices if the battery compartment is not secure, make certain that the spare batteries are kept locked away and unused batteries are disposed of correctly.

If your child does swallow a button cell battery (lithium battery) seek immediate medical attention.

Don't take risks with lithium batteries – the result can be catastrophic
