Across County Durham approximately 69 children aged 0-5 attend accident and emergency departments every day with injuries following accidents at home, some of which would be preventable.

I write with details of child safety programme available to all staff working across County Durham. This exciting new training which is part of the County Durham Strategy for the Prevention of Unintentional Injuries in Children and Young People will raise awareness of some of the main causes of accidents to children and will explore how you can promote home safety messages to parents and carers.
