- •Minimal distress when the parent leaves the child alone and will immediately seek comfort when they return.
- •Parents respond appropriately to their child's needs.
- •The child trusts their needs will be met by the parent

- •The child is wary of strangers.
- •The child becomes distressed when the parent leaves.
- •The child is not comforted by the return of their parent.
- •The child can display direct aggression towards the parent.
