

Information sheet for those attending NSPCC licensed GCP2 training

This is a short information sheet that will ensure you are fully aware of what the expectations are when you attend the NSPCC licensed GCP2 Training. You have been asked to attend the training as your managers believe you will be enthusiastic and skilled to use GCP2 in your practice.

- The GCP2 is a tool that supports practitioners to make a judgement about whether or not parental care is neglectful.
- You will be trained to use the NSPCC GCP2.

The training takes place over one day and will cover:

- Short session on what neglect is
- A session on the GCP2 research
- The theory that underpins GCP2
- A case study that you will need to score using GCP2
- Analysing the completed tool

There is an expectation that you will not only attend the training but that you will pass the case study assessment to be able to use the tool. Therefore, it is important that you are there at the beginning and stay until the end to ensure you receive all parts of the training. Successful passing of the assessment allows you to use GCP2 in the geographical area that is licensed to use the tool. Hence if you move locations to an area that itself does not hold the licence, you cannot use GCP2 there. But, you can if that area has a licence.
